MATERIALS SHOPPING LIST

For Creating Quilled Shapes with Paper Type

Art Clay Paper Type, 75x75mm size or 200x40mm size
 Art Clay Silver Paste, 10g jar
 Slotted quilling tool, 3-6 inch, with slot at the end to catch/wind
 Basic Quilling Patterns file download
 Metal ruler with millimeters
 Circle sizer for consistency in sizing coils
 Craft knife, such as X-acto or Excel
 Piece of metal or mirror for checking dryness
 Cutting surface



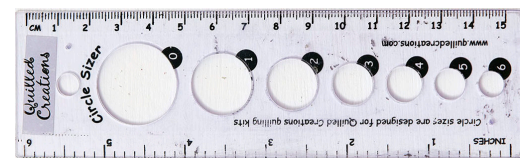
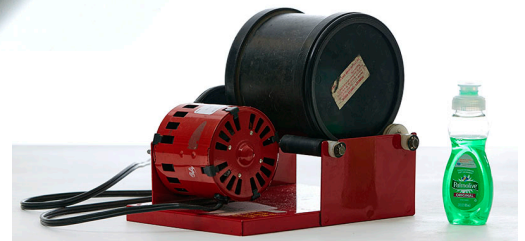
For Firing (Must be kiln fired)

A programmable, front-load kiln, such as Paragon 120-volt SC2 or SC3
 Two kiln shelves of compressed refractory ceramic fiber board
 Ceramic kiln shelf feet
 Welder's gloves or oven gloves
 Tongs



For Designing

Tweezers
 Non-stick work surface
 Pancake griddle or candle warmer for drying your design at no more than 200 degrees F
 Fine-tipped paintbrush
 Small cup of water
 Cheap plastic pipette for diluting new bottles of Paste
 Stirring needle for your Paste
 Paper towels
 Elmer's glue
 Toothpicks



For Finishing

Tumbler
 2 lbs stainless steel mixed shot
 Dawn or Palmolive dish soap
 Agate burnisher (optional)

For More Finishing Options

1/2 inch 20 gauge round fine silver wire
 Wire cutters
 5-6mm diameter half-drilled pearl
 Adhesive glue
